- Located in the heart of Canada's largest wine region, the Niagara College Teaching Winery is Canada's first commercial teaching winery, and supports students in Niagara College's School of Food and Wine Sciences.
- Based on models from the world's great wine regions, the Niagara College Teaching Winery is a key element of the college's award-winning winery and viticulture programs, including the Winery and Viticulture Technician Diploma program, the Wine Business Management post-graduate program, the Certified Sommelier program, Niagara Wine 101 and Continuing Education certificates.
- In Fall 2009, the Niagara College Teaching Winery moved into new facilities in Niagara College's Wine Visitor + Education Centre (WVEC). The facility will serve as a living laboratory for the College's wine, culinary and tourism students and celebrate the Ontario and Canadian grape and wine industry through informative displays and an information centre to assist visitors in their exploration of wines and wine country.
- The Niagara College Teaching Winery is supported by 40 acres of teaching vineyards – the Jack Forrer Vineyard and the Donald J. P. Ziraldo Vineyard.
